All ages are welcome. Seat saving is not permitted. Seats are limited to first come, first served.



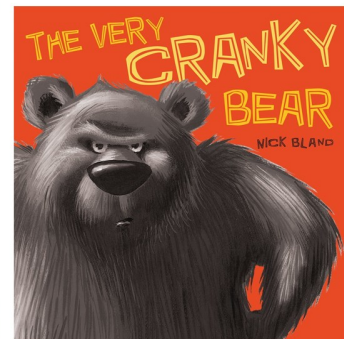
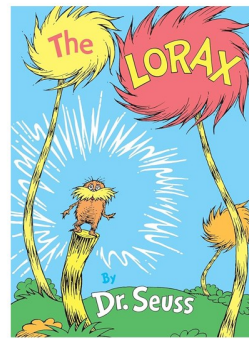

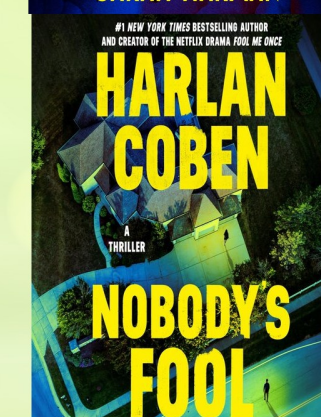
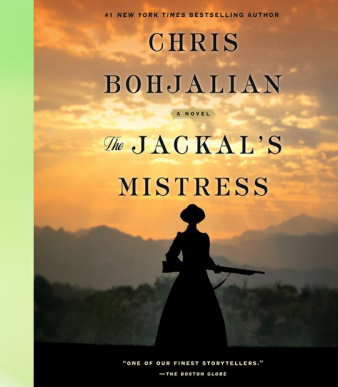
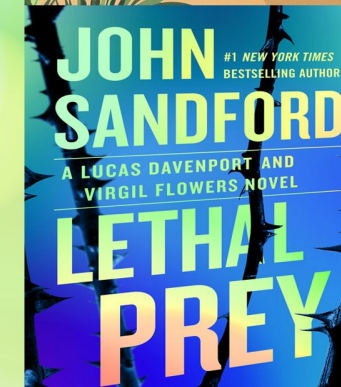
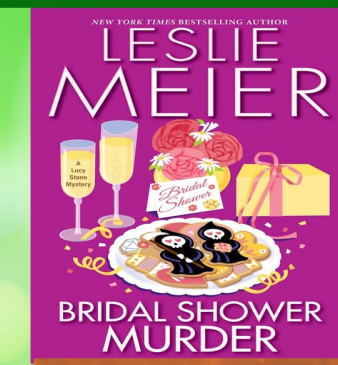
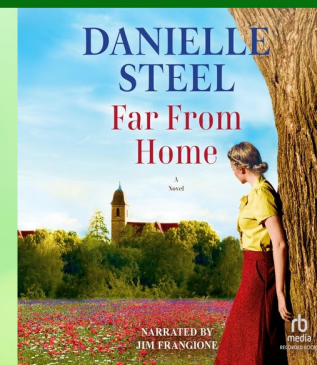
March 7th | 1pm | Ages birth - 6
