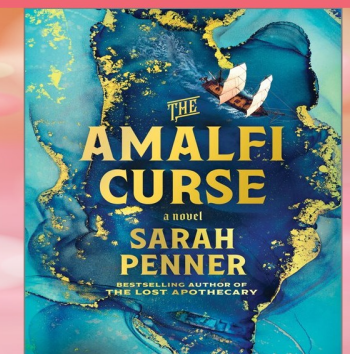
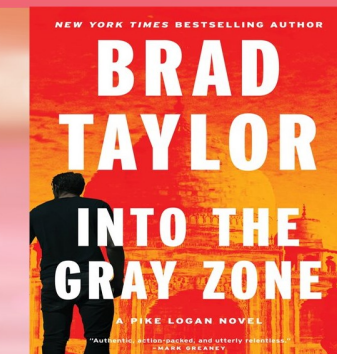
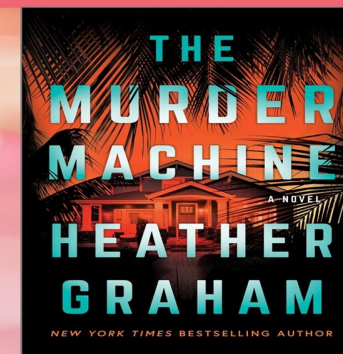


## Staff Review

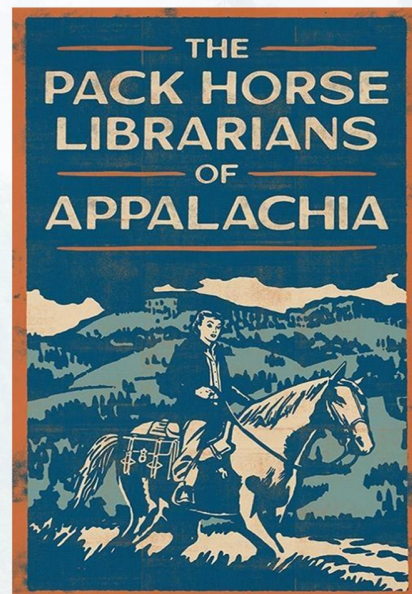


## PACK HORSE LIBRARIANS OF EASTERN KENTUCKY

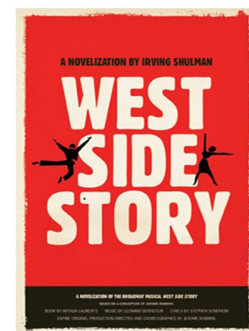


